Labor Category	COMPUTER SCIENTIST
<i>Brief Description of Responsibilities</i>	Acts as a senior consultant in complex or mission critical client requirements. Develops, modifies, and applies computer modeling and programming applications to analyze and solve mathematical and scientific problems affecting system and program performance. Participates in all phases of scientific and engineering projects such as research, design, development, testing, modeling, simulating, training, and documentation.
